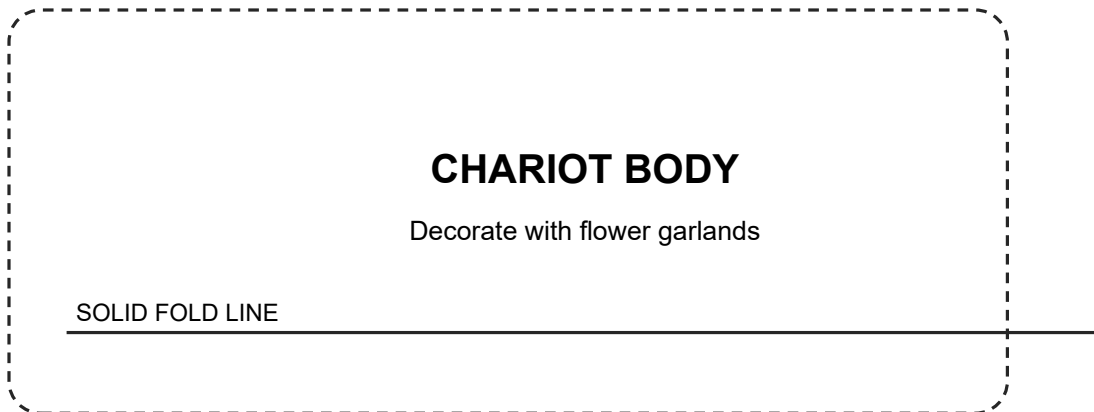
The Wedding and the Heavenly Voice | 25 minutes

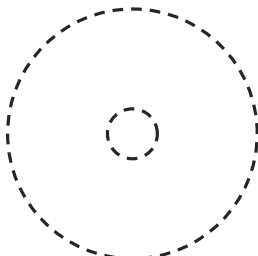

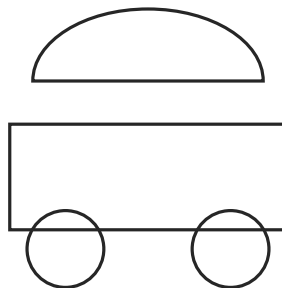
CHARIOT BODY

Decorate with flower garlands

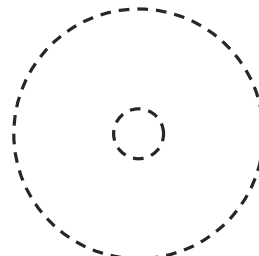

Assembly steps

1. Color the parts before cutting.
2. Cut only on dotted lines; fold on solid lines.
3. Attach both wheels and canopy to the chariot body.
4. Place Kamsa at the front driving; place adult Devaki and adult Vasudeva behind him.
5. Order the four story cards, then act out the scene.

Role-play the chariot scene

The Wedding and the Heavenly Voice | 25 minutes

Story connection

Kamsa drove Devaki and Vasudeva when the heavenly voice changed the celebration.

Narrator: A heavenly voice warns Ka

Line: "I will help in Narrator: A heavenly voice warns Kamsa about Devaki's eighth child.'s part of the story."
Action: Act the story moment.

Prop: simple cloth

Kamsa (paraphrase): Fear rises as h

Line: "I will help in Kamsa (paraphrase): Fear rises as he hears the warning about the eighth child.'s part of the story."
Action: Act the story moment.

Prop: simple cloth

Vasudeva (paraphrase): He calmly pr

Line: "I will help in Vasudeva (paraphrase): He calmly promises to bring every child and asks Kamsa not to harm Devaki.'s part of the story."
Action: Act the story moment.

Prop: simple cloth

Devaki (paraphrase): She stays clos

Line: "I will help in Devaki (paraphrase): She stays close to Vasudeva and trusts his truthful promise.'s part of the story."
Action: Act the story moment.
