Vasudeva Keeps His Word | 18 minutes

Story connection

Vasudeva keeps his word after Kīrtimān's birth; Kāṁsa is astonished and returns the child, but Vasudeva remains cautious.

- Number the six events in story order.
- Draw one source-faithful detail on each card.



Kāṁsa says he fears the eighth child.

Number + draw one detail



Kīrtimān is born.

Number + draw one detail



Kāṁsa returns Kīrtimān.

Number + draw one detail



Vasudeva remembers his promise.

Number + draw one detail



Kāṁsa is astonished by Vasudeva's honesty.

Number + draw one detail



Vasudeva brings Kīrtimān to Kāṁsa.

Promise and duty decision tree

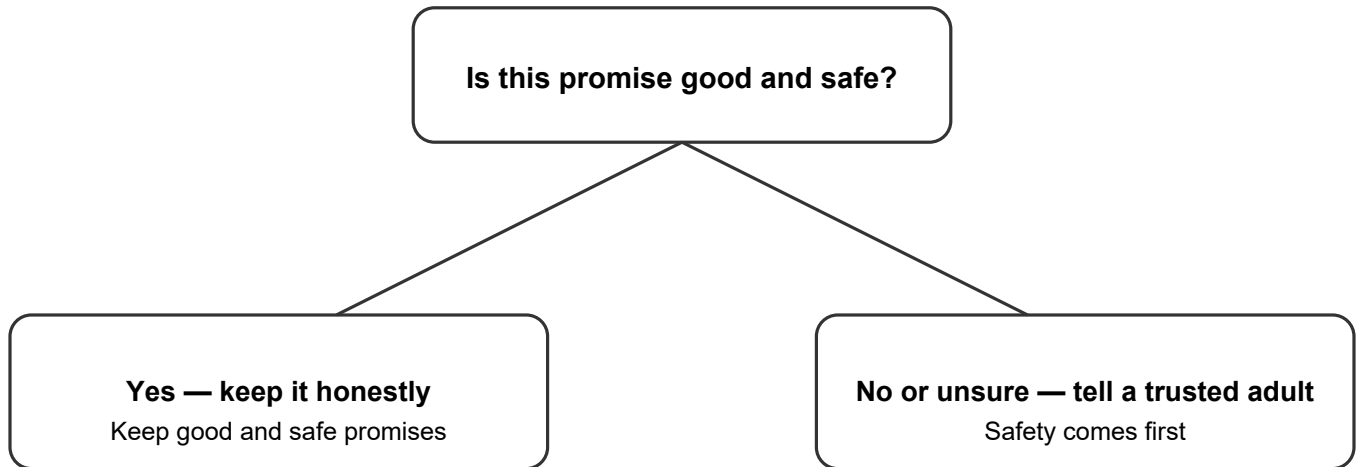
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Promise and duty decision tree

- Follow each branch and choose truthfulness with wise help.
- Mark the path Vasudeva chose, then discuss when to ask a trusted adult.
- Good and safe promises should be kept. If a promise could hurt someone, asks you to hide an unsafe secret, or makes you frightened, tell a trusted adult.



Family promise card

One promise I can keep with care:

Safety comes first; never hide an unsafe secret—tell a trusted adult.
