

Role cards

Narada's Warning and Kamsa's Decision | 22 minutes

Story connection

Nārada warns Kāṁsa, fear drives harsh choices, and Devakī and Vasudeva remain faithful to the Lord.

Nārada

Line: "The divine plan is unfolding among the Yadu and Vṛṣṇi families."

Action: Speak calmly to Kāṁsa.

Prop: small scarf

Kāṁsa

Line: "Fear is filling my mind, and I am choosing control."

Action: Show alarm without shouting.

Prop: paper crown

Devakī

Line: "We will remain composed and remember the Lord."

Action: Stand peacefully beside Vasudeva.

Prop: flower

Vasudeva

Line: "Even here, let us keep faith and act with dignity."

Action: Offer a reassuring gesture.

Prop: folded cloth

Narrator

Line: "Kāṁsa removed Ugrasena from power and imprisoned the devoted couple."

Action: Move the scene-order cards.

Prop: story cards

Scene-order cards

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Nārada warns Kāṁsa, fear drives harsh choices, and Devakī and Vasudeva remain faithful to the Lord.

- Number the shuffled cards from 1 to 6.
- Retell the episode without adding later events.

Ugrasena is removed from rule.

Nārada arrives.

Nārada explains the divine plan.

Devakī and Vasudeva are imprisoned.
