

Put the Birth Night in Order

The Birth of Lord Krishna | 18 minutes

Story connection

This activity follows Krishna Book Chapter 3: auspicious signs, Krishna's four-armed appearance, the parents' prayers, His infant form, and the prison doors opening so Vasudeva can carry Him.

- The six cards are shuffled on purpose.
- Number them in true story order.



Krishna assumed the form of an ordinary infant.

Number + draw one detail



Auspicious signs appeared as the sacred night approached.

Number + draw one detail



Vasudeva's chains loosened and the prison doors opened.

Number + draw one detail



Krishna appeared before Devaki and Vasudeva in His four-armed form.

Number + draw one detail



Vasudeva prepared to carry Krishna according to the Lord's arrangement.

Number + draw one detail



Devaki and Vasudeva offered prayers.
