

Put Chapter 4 in Order

Kamsa Begins His Persecutions | 18 minutes

Story connection

This activity follows Krishna Book Chapter 4: Yoga-māyā's revelation as eight-armed Durgā, Kāṁsa's temporary release of Devakī and Vasudeva, and the demonic ministers' counsel to persecute devotees and saintly culture.

- The six cards are shuffled on purpose.
- Number them in true story order.

Yoga-māyā rose as eight-armed Durgā and warned Kāṁsa.

Number + draw one detail

Yoga-māyā cried and the guards told Kāṁsa.

Number + draw one detail

Vasudeva taught about bodily identification and enmity.

Number + draw one detail

Kāṁsa rushed in; Devakī pleaded for the baby girl.

Number + draw one detail

Demonic ministers advised persecution; Kāṁsa authorized it.

Number + draw one detail

Kāṁsa released Devakī and Vasudeva and asked forgiveness.
