

Crawling adventure role cards

Kṛṣṇa and Balarāma's Crawling Adventures | 20 minutes

Story connection

Toddler Kṛṣṇa crawls with ankle bells, steals butter and sweets in playful mischief, and the mothers of Vraja watch with affectionate laughter (Krishna Book / crawling adventures).

Narrator

Line: Toddler Kṛṣṇa crawls through Vraja with jingling bells and sparkling eyes.

Action: Tap a steady rhythm to start each short scene.

Prop: wooden spoon as bell cue

Baby Kṛṣṇa

Line: I crawl toward the butter pots and smile as if nothing is missing.

Action: Crawl two steps and peek behind open hands.

Prop: small empty yogurt cup

Cowherd boy friend

Line: Follow Him—He is heading for the sweets again!

Action: Tip-toe behind Kṛṣṇa and point toward the pots.

Prop: paper peacock feather shape

Gopī mother

Line: Who took a handful from my pot? Those tiny footprints give it away.

Action: Place hands on hips, then laugh kindly.

Prop: kitchen towel

Yaśodā

Line: Come, my restless child—wash those butter-shiny fingers.

Action: Kneel and mime wiping little hands with care.

Prop: soft napkin

Crawling mischief matching
