

Govardhana worship sequence

Worshiping Govardhana Hill | 18 minutes

Story connection

Krishna Book Ch.24: Nanda's planned Indra sacrifice; Krishna teaches cow protection and Vraja's duty; Annakūṭa worship of Govardhana; offerings accepted—no storm or hill-lifting (that is Ch.25).

- Number the seven cards in true Ch.24 order.
- Do not add rain or hill-lifting—those belong to the next chapter.



The community gathers Annakūṭa foods and offerings for Govardhana.

Number + draw one detail



Krishna assumes a great Govardhana form and accepts the offerings.

Number + draw one detail



Nanda prepares the customary sacrifice for Indra.

Number + draw one detail



The worship finishes in joy; everyone is satisfied.

Number + draw one detail



They honor brāhmaṇas, cows, animals, and people with the feast.

Number + draw one detail



Krishna asks why and teaches that Vraja should honor cows and Govardhana.

Number + draw one detail



Villagers decorate the cows and circumambulate Govardhana Hill.

Cow protection vs Indra sacrifice

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Match each figure to why they came

- Match Krishna's teaching to what Vraja should honor.

A. Indra sacrifice alone

Honor the hill that shelters and feeds

B. Protecting cows and calves

Vraja's real work and affection

C. Worshiping Govardhana

Looks upward but can forget local duty

D. Annakūṭa feast shared

Offer and distribute food with love

Younger: Order the feast cards; draw decorated cows—no storm. Older: Order Annakūṭa and explain cow protection vs Indra-yajña in Krishna's words.
