Devastating Rainfall in Vrindavana | 18 minutes

Story connection

Krishna Book Ch.25: Indra's pride; Sāṁvartaka clouds; Krishna lifts Govardhana on His left little finger; seven days of shelter; clouds stop; hill replaced; affectionate embraces. No Surabhi or milk abhiṣeka.

- Number the seven cards in true Ch.25 order.
- Circle the card where Krishna lifts the hill on His left little finger.



Krishna lifts Govardhana on the little finger of His left hand.

Indra becomes proud and angry that his sacrifice was stopped.

Number + draw one detail



Indra orders the Sāṁvartaka clouds to stop; the sky clears.

Number + draw one detail



Cows shield their calves; the residents pray to Krishna for protection.

Number + draw one detail



Krishna replaces the hill in its place; residents embrace Him with blessings.

He sends the fierce Sāṁvartaka clouds to flood Vṛndāvana.

Everyone with animals and belongings shelters safely for seven days.
